- iii. Thirdly, the need to fully comprehend the government's policy framework, relevant laws including rules and regulations pertaining to your business sector;
- iv. Fourthly, to identify and benchmark against the best global models available;
- v. Fifthly, to be creative in raising the necessary funds and capital required;
- vi. Sixthly, to choose credible business partners with similar vision and objectives to help you grow your business;

- vii. Seventhly, to persevere through challenges and failures from time to time. As Richard Branson once said "Do not be embarrassed by your failures, learn from them and start again."
  Even Churchill once said, "Success is not final, failure is not fatal. It is the courage to continue that counts.";
- viii. Eightly, to be prepared to work hard and know how to work smart;
- ix. Ninethly, to have a wide network of business associates;
- Tenthly, to have a good data base in respect of your business and related sectors;
- xi. Eleventhly, to be able to acquire and use new knowledge so as to be ahead of your business competitors;
- xii. Twelfthly, to leverage on new technology to reduce operational costs and enhance efficiency and, last but not least;
- xiii. To hire competent and efficient management and support staff, loyal and dedicated and passionate to attaining your business objectives.

10. The road ahead to be a successful entrepreneur is fraught with obstacles.

11. It will be an illusion to think that every thing you try to do and every business decision you make will be rewarded with success. However, if to be an entrepreneur is your choice in life, ultimately, only you yourself can determine and shape your destiny.
